Aetna Student Health will continue as our provider for 2009-2010. Specific benefit details for 2009-2010 are available at the following website:

Student academic appointees (SAA) appointed at 37.5% FTE or above per semester or are fellowship recipients with an award of \$3,262 or more per semester will be automatically enrolled in the SAA health insurance plan. All SAAs and Fellowship Recipients must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours each semester (summer excluded). There is no out-of-pocket cost to the student for plan premiums.

For those students who have comparable coverage and do not wish to coordinate two separate insurance plans, there is an option to waive out of the plan. **A waiver form must be completed for each semester the student wants to waive out.** Waiver forms can be downloaded at <http://faa.iupui.edu/newFaa/resources/StudHealth-WAIVER.doc> and must be filed by the deadlines listed below with the Assistant Dean of the Faculties, Carol McGarry, AO 126:

Fall Waiver September 30, 2009  
Spring Waiver January 30, 2010

There is dependent coverage available for a spouse, same sex partner, or children. It is the responsibility of the student to complete enrollment for dependents by September 15, 2009.
